From the life intensifying Macan to the unadulterated driving pleasure of the new Cayman GTS and Boxster GTS models, enthusiasts in China will have the unique opportunity to enjoy the latest Porsche innovations in their full splendour.



PORSCHE INSPIRES ENTHUSIASTS AT AUTO CHINA 2014

At Porsche, we know only one direction. Forward. For us, innovation and excellence are not goals. They are requirements. We see these unshakable principles put into effect at Auto China 2014, where our latest cutting-edge models once again take the spotlight. Gracing the stage of the prestigious auto show will be the new 911 RSR and the new 919 Hybrid. A tribute to our motorsports legacy, these models signal our triumphant return to Le Mans 24 Hours and the World Endurance Championship.

THE NEW MACAN. LIFE. INTENSIFIED.

Five doors. Five seats. All-wheel drive and a more elevated position. These are the characteristics of a compact SUV. Add a thirst for new experiences, a yearning for exhilaration and a dash of unpredictability, and you have the Macan, the latest model from Porsche that promises to change the very way we think about cars.



The Macan. The word means "tiger" in Indonesian, and represents the first compact SUV ever to bear the Porsche crest. With a low centre of gravity, this latest Porsche innovation feels more like a sports car than an SUV. True to its name, it masters the most challenging of corners with unprecedented agility.

With the addition of Porsche Traction Management (PTM) and 7-speed Porsche Doppelkupplung (PDK) transmission, the Macan remains light-footed and tenacious on even the most challenging off-road terrain. Meanwhile, the car's lightweight chassis and the addition of Porsche Active Suspension Management (PASM) remove any lingering doubt that what you are driving is in fact a Porsche sports car.

Solidifying the Macan's sports car DNA is its impressive performance. The 3.6-litre engine in the Macan Turbo delivers an immense power output of 294 kW (400 hp), sprinting from 0 to 100 km/h in just 4.8 seconds, with a top speed of 266 km/h. The Macan S, on the other hand, is able to achieve speeds of up to 254 km/h and accelerate from 0 to 100 km/h in a mere 5.4 seconds, thanks to its 3.0-litre twin-turbo engine. The new Macan, currently celebrating its debut at Auto China, also packs a punch. Its 2.0-litre four cylinder engine delivers 174 kW (237 hp), accelerating from 0 to 100 km/h in only 6.9 seconds and reaching a top speed of 223 km/h.

The Macan excels in all areas. Efficiency is no exception. The cutting-edge compact SUV once again proves that even high-

performance sports cars can achieve comparatively moderate emission values. With state-of-the-art engines which not only reach their operating temperature quickly but also use relatively little fuel, the Macan, for all its power, is remarkably efficient.

The sports car heritage of the Macan is evident in many details of its design. A sloping roof line at the rear end. Distinctive sideblades at the bottom of the front and rear doors. A sharp profile which embodies the car's dynamic essence. Like any true Porsche, it is compact, powerful and close to the road. As if the sporty exterior of the Macan were not enough to convince you, its interior is also unmistakably Porsche. From the low front seats, the sloping centre con-

sole with display and operation concept through to the extensive range of customisation options, the interior offers both a sense of familiarity and striking new features.

A sports car with the body of an SUV, the Macan represents Porsche ingenuity at its finest. With a groundbreaking design and astonishing performance, this cutting-edge Porsche innovation is sure to set even higher standards in the field of driving versatility and enjoyment – both on city streets and off-road terrain.

original Targa with the sporty character of the 911, the revolutionary new Targa roof invokes the classic shape of the original design with its distinctive side fins, 'Targa' logo and crisp, clean lines. Meanwhile, the new Targa bar, fitted with an aluminium trim, emanates a sporty metallic sheen.

The figures speak for themselves: with a 294 kW (400 hp) flat engine, the 911 Targa 4S completes the 0 to 100 km/h sprint in just 4.6 seconds and can continue on to an impressive top speed of 294 km/h. Meanwhile, the Targa 4 reaches speeds of up to 280 km/h and accelerates from 0 to 100 km/h in a mere 5.0 seconds.

Now in its seventh generation, the 911 RSR debuted in 2013, where it finished first and second in its class at Le Mans 24 Hours. As if that wasn't enough, this iconic sports car is now kicking off the most extensive Porsche motorsport programme in history with the World Endurance Championship series.

With a stellar track record, an innovative design and motorsport DNA, the 911 RSR is leading the way for track cars of the future.

The 919 Hybrid

The 919 Hybrid is the most complex racecar that Porsche has ever built.

From its lightweight chassis and sleek aesthetic to its compact four-cylinder combustion engine, which delivers an astounding 500 hp, there is no question about the car's world-class performance and classic sports car heritage.

But it won't be the fastest car that wins the grueling Le Mans 24 Hours this year. It will be the most efficient. This is where the 919 Hybrid truly stands out from the competition. A sports car on the cutting edge of design and engineering, the latest Porsche hybrid incorporates two energy recovery systems. PORSCHE CARRERA CUP ASIA 2014

THE BATTLE BEGINS

For over a decade, the Porsche Carrera Cup Asia has been at the forefront of Asian motorsports, with unparalleled racing skill from its entry of drivers, cutting-edge technology with the new 911 GT3 Cup car and a selection of thrilling circuits. After kicking off its 12th season on the Sepang International Circuit in Malaysia, the competition is on track to set the racing world on fire with even more adrenaline fuelled battles spanning the width of Asia.

Like the Porsche marque itself, the Porsche Carrera Cup Asia is ever changing, retaining a strong core identity while pushing the boundaries of what is possible on the track. This year's competition is further intensified with the entry of the new Porsche 911 GT3 Cup car, which makes its debut at the championship.

The powerful 3.8-litre flat six engine produces 460 horsepower, 10 more than the previous model, and the six-speed sequential gearbox is operated by a pneumatic paddle shift system, a first for the Porsche Carrera Cup Asia. Other enhancements include an upgraded break system and new one-piece racing wheels, while safety features have been further enhanced with a newly developed roll cage and a new drivers' seat.

Further strengthening ties with Porsche motorsport activities across Asia, we also see the series touch down in Japan for the first time in 2014, as it takes on the prestigious Fuji International Speedway in June. Renowned for its challenging technicalities and one of the longest straights in the world (1,500 metres),

the legendary circuit will host rounds 5 and 6 of the competition, complementing an already stellar roster of racing locations including Shanghai, Singapore and Malaysia. Double headers at China's Pearl River Delta Region Zhuhai track, and at Malaysia's Sepang circuit, see the region's premier international sportscar championship cross the Tropic of Cancer four times as it thunders towards the season finale in Shanghai.

With world-class sports cars and exhilarating circuits, there is one final piece needed to make the Porsche Carrera Cup Asia whole: the talent. Traditionally, the Porsche Carrera Cup Asia has drawn from a pool of magnificent international racing prowess. This year, the lineup looks better than ever. Entering the glamor-

ous and fiercely-competitive world of motorsport is Zheng Tong Auto, with 21-year-old Chinese driver Zhang Da Sheng from Beijing and Team Synsanly which has selected Porsche Carrera Cup Asia newcomer and reigning Scirocco Cup champion Bao Jin Long as its debut driver. They join the eight existing dealer teams, including PICC Team StarChase with 2012 champion Alexandre Imperatori; Team C&D with the talented Jason Zhang Zhi Qiang; Team Porsche Holding with 2013 championship runner-up Martin Ragginger; Team Jebsen with Rodolfo Avila; Team Betterlife and last season's Class B second runner-up Li Chao; Team Basetex with 21-year-old newcomer Zhang Zhen Dong; Team Kangshun with Singapore veteran Ringo Chong and last but not least, Team Yongda Dongfang with series newcomer Ro.C. Skyangel of Singapore.





Leading the way in 2014 is reigning champion Earl Bamber, who returns this year with LKM Racing Team. In a season which was nothing short of phenomenal, Bamber clinched the 2013 Porsche Carrera Cup Asia title; winning the Porsche Motorsport International Cup scholarship and securing himself a full season in 2014 in the Porsche Mobil 1 Supercup. At just 23-years-of-age, the young New Zealand talent is now racing for Porsche full-time and will defend his Asian title ferociously.

While it has been proven beyond doubt that winning the overall championship of the Porsche Carrera Cup Asia is one of the greatest honours in the motor racing world, the level of competition amongst Class B drivers can be just as intense. With Egidio Perfetti competing for the overall title this year, following an impressive class B win last year, a hot favourite for the 2014 Class B title is Singapore's Yuey Tan, second in the championship last season.

However, the Dorr Havelock Racing driver can expect fierce competition both from his traditional rivals, with Open Road Racing Team's Francis Tjia and 23-year-old hot shot Alif Hamdan from Nexus Racing, as well as several new faces, including Johnson Huang of BC Racing Team and returning driver Kenneth Lau of Prince Racing Hong Kong.

As the lights go out and the field of 28 new Porsche 911 GT3 Cup racing cars rocket off the grid, drivers will compete for honour and glory on the international racing stage. With finely honed talent, world-class machinery and the most challenging tracks in Asia, this year's Porsche Carrera Cup Asia promises to be nothing short of spectacular.

THE 911 TARGA EVOLUTION OF A SPORTS CAR ICON

The 911 Targa took the world by storm when it made its debut at the Frankfurt Motor Show in 1965. Derived from the 911 Coupé, the original concept design for the Targa was an ingenious solution from Porsche to American safety regulations. With its roll-over bars and removable folding roof, the first Targa model was delivered, fulfilling the dreams of sports car enthusiasts around the world.

The Targa name alone is the stuff of legends. It originates from the famous endurance race held in Sicily, Italy: the Targa Florio. The course was notorious for its tight bends which the comparatively compact Porsche race cars of the 60s were able to use to their advantage, chalking up a number of victories in the process. 'Targa' means 'shield' in Italian and thus the name also became symbolic of the 'protective shield' provided by the innovative safety concept of the 911 Targa.

The car has seen many changes since its debut almost 50 years ago. Even its most distinctive feature, a sturdy bar complete with three fins and the 'Targa'

logo, has seen numerous adjustments and improvements over the years.

Back in 1975, the original silver bar was replaced with a black one for the 'G-series' version of the 911 Targa. Then, in 1995, the world watched as the latest Targa debuted with a revolutionary new roof concept: an electrically operated glass ceiling with aluminium trim strips running along the sides. Since then, the Targa has been refined and perfected, pushing the limits of design and performance.

PERFORMANCE PRINCIPLES

Porsche Sport Driving School with Chief Instructor Arnd Stollmann

Welcome to *Performance Principles*, as we look at some more questions from the Porsche Sport Driving School. In this issue, Porsche China Chief Instructor, Arnd Stollmann, takes a look at how to properly adjust the driver's seat of your Porsche.

How do I adjust the driver's seat properly?

Mr Zhang, Guangzhou

Upon entering a car, a driver should first adjust the seat to his/her height. The distance of the seat from the pedals should be altered so that the knees are slightly bent when the pedals are fully pressed. Next comes the adjustment of the distance between the driver and the steering wheel. With the hands extended over the top of the steering wheel, the wrists should rest just on the rim of it, that's when one knows it is positioned correctly.

Then there is the headrest to be adjusted. Should a collision occur, the incorrect position of the headrest could cause various degrees of injuries to the neck and head. The ideal positioning of the head rest should be centered and aligned with the centre of the back of the head, with two fingers width in-between. The backrest ought to be adjusted at an angle of about 100 degrees with regard to the surface of the seat, with the lumbar support raised as high as possible, which is good for comfort and reduces driving fatigue.

Last but not the least; ensure you wear your seat belt at all times. As a vital protection in case of an accident, its importance should never be underestimated, even in cars with airbags.



Zero interruption. Superbly smooth. Extremely fast gear changes. How is this possible? The answer is Porsche Doppelkupplungsgetriebe (PDK), one of the numerous innovations that contributed to over 30,000 race victories in the illustrious motorsport history of Porsche.

First introduced in the Porsche 962C, a motorsport legend that dominated the sports car racing world in the 1980s, the PDK combined dynamic driving performance and the mechanical efficiency of a manual transmission with the shift and driving comfort of an automatic gearbox. The PDK combines two gearboxes together with the power transferred via one of the gearboxes, while the other gearbox stands by for the next gear. As a result, the Porsche Doppelkupplungsgetriebe (PDK) allows lightning shifts with a response time of under 100 milliseconds; an immense advantage which not only boosts driving performance, but also results in reduced fuel consumption.

In 2008, amid the fervent expectation of Porsche cus-

tomers, the race-only technology was applied to production sports cars, first offered on the 911 Carrera, and later offered for other model ranges - with specific developments customised to fit their different drive systems. Last year, the PDK was thoroughly reworked by Porsche engineers for an even higher level of capabilities on the new 911 GT3, which accelerates from 0 to 100 km/h within just 3.5 seconds and mastered the Nürburgring Northern Loop, the famous Green Hell, in under 7 minutes and 30 seconds.

A unique feature in Porsche sports cars, the PDK will also be offered for the newest member of the Porsche family, the Macan, promising to further enhance its performance and satisfy Porsche enthusiasts' need for life-intensifying experiences.
