PORSCHE CARRERA CUP ASIA 2014. ROUNDS 11 & 12.

From 19 – 21 October, the Porsche Carrera Cup Asia reached a thrilling climax as racers descended on Shanghai for the final two rounds of the season. Here, on the unforgiving asphalt of the Shanghai International Circuit, the elite drivers of Asia's premiere racing series battled for the ultimate prize: the honour of being crowned champion.

As the lights went out for Round 11, LKM Racing's Earl Bamber got away like lightning off the flag, leaving Alexandre Imperatori of PICC Team Starchase, Team Porsche Holding's Martin Ragginger and Rodolfo Avila of Team Jebsen in hot pursuit. Behind the race leaders, the battle was already heating up between the two drivers who would be the stars of the show: Zheng Tong Auto's Zhang Da Sheng of China and Team Yongda Dongfang's Ro.C. Skyangel.

With Zhang piling on the pressure, Skyangel faltered allowing

his rival by, only for the Singaporean to immediately strike back. The pair went back and forth once again, engaged in a crowd-thrilling cat and mouse chase to the line. A big moment just two laps from the flag saw Zhang lose time giving Skyangel some breathing space. Meanwhile up in front, Bamber took another victory and with it the championship title after a flawless flag-to-pole run, leaving Imperatori and Ragginger in second and third place respectively.

As drivers lined up on the starting grid for the 12^{th} and final round of the season, the competition was no less fierce. Not content to rest on his laurels, champion Bamber stormed off the grid the second the light turned green, immediately moving to the inside and blocking Ragginger.

Lap 5 saw Ragginger up the ante and headlights-ablaze he mounted his attack on the race leader but try as he might, ice-cool Bamber was not to be ruffled. A lap later,







Nexus Racing's Alif Hamdan tried to go up the inside of Zhang Da Sheng and the pair made contact, a heart-stopping moment for his legions of fans. The warning worked though, and he refocused on the main prize of the Class B title.

The Safety Car was brought out after Team Kangshun's Ringo Chong ended up in the gravel, closing up the field. At the restart on Lap 9, Bamber was away well chased by Ragginger and Imperatori, while Avila skillfully held off a challenge from guest racer Carlo Van Dam behind. Seconds later, Imperatori ran wide and Avila saw his chance to close in. The pair fought tooth and claw all the way to the flag, inches between then as they thundered across the line for the final time this season.

The finale came to a thrilling conclusion as Bamber closed out a perfect season with another victory, with Ragginger and Imperatori securing second and third place in the over-

all standings. Meanwhile, Hamdan claimed the coveted Class B title with yet another victory, putting him in good stead for his future racing career. Second and third in the Class B standings were Yuey Tan of Dorr Havelock Racing and OpenRoad Racing's Francis Tjia.

Fiery battles, heated rivalries and burning rubber. From the ever challenging Marina Bay track in Singapore to the gleaming stands of the Shanghai International Circuit. What a season it has been for the Porsche Carrera Cup Asia. Alas, all good things must come to an end. As the competition hailed its new champions, thoughts were already turning to the 2015 season. Scheduled to start early next year with a new grid of international drivers, Porsche Carrera Cup Asia 2015 promises deliver the fierce exhilaration we have come to expect from a competition of this caliber. 


Top driving tips from the Porsche Sport Driving School team.

Welcome to *Performance Principles*, where the Porsche Sport Driving School provides driving tips to help make your journeys more safe and more enjoyable in your Porsche. In this issue we look at a few essential tips for driving your Porsche hybrid model more efficiently.

How do I drive my hybrid more efficiently?

Mr Wang, Harbin

- 1. Charge the battery via the vehicle's charge port: Do so overnight in the garage or charging station. The energy from the high-voltage battery can be used for electric driving.
- **2. Use auxiliary functions sparingly:** Seat heating, windscreen demisting and air-conditioning should all be minimized to save power.
- **3. Take advantage of stop-and-go urban traffic:** When driving in the city, use E-Power mode and don't be afraid to use the breaks. Remember that a hybrid's kinetic energy is best used for forward movement. No energy is wasted through excessive braking or acceleration.
- **4.** Take your foot off the accelerator and "glide": The moment you remove your foot from the accelerator, the combustion engine is switched off and disengaged automatically. The vehicle then rolls along without using any drive power.



5. Use E-Charge mode on motorways:

Given the higher power requirement, the combustion engine is generally used when driving on motorways or dual carriageways. As a result, the electric machine can function as a generator for charging the high-voltage battery.

6. Avoid accelerating at full throttle: The combustion engine is more efficient during moderate acceleration. Additionally, at a moderate rate of acceleration, the vehicle is more likely to be able to run purely on electric power.

PLUG-IN HYBRID TECHNOLOGY. THE NEXT STAGE IN HYBRID EVOLUTION.

The results are in. Plug-in hybrids offer reduced emissions, improved efficiency and longer adventures on the road and track. But just what is this new technology, and why is it so important?

Like traditional hybrids, plug-in hybrids use both internal combustion engines and electric motors for drive. However, there is one important difference: plug-in hybrids can be recharged by plugging into an external power source. With powerful electric drives delivering most of the power, the new cars consume less fuel, which means less green house gas emissions and a smaller carbon footprint. Furthermore, the cars are also able to constantly recuperate and recharge their battery while driving, and can be recharged quickly and easily at home and require fewer gas fill-ups.


Not only do plug-in hybrids offer a more environmentally friendly and convenient alternative to their pure gasoline counterparts, they also solve a major problem associated with all-electric cars: range anxiety. Thanks to a powerful combustion engine that acts as a back up in the event of battery depletion, the new cars achieve unparalleled range, demonstrating their viability as automobiles of the future.

Ever at the forefront of cutting-edge technology, Porsche has three plug-in hybrids in its lineup: the Panamera S E-Hybrid, the 918 Spyder and the all new Cayenne S E-Hybrid. With powerful electric motors and higher-performance lithium-ion batteries, the new models deliver excellent performance while consuming very little fuel.

The Panamera S E-Hybrid's electric drive produces 95 hp (70 kW), more than double than that of its predecessor, and reduces fuel consumption by 56%. Meanwhile, the 918 Spyder features two electric motors, one on the front axle and one on the rear axle. Not only do these motors drastically increase efficiency, they also improve driving dynamics by controlling each axle independently.

The Cayenne S E-Hybrid is the latest Porsche hybrid and the first of its kind in the Cayenne family. It features a 95 hp (70kW) electric motor, significantly reducing fuel consumption without any compromise in terms of sporty performance.

Together, these models represent the future of hybrid technology. Maximum power with minimum consumption, environmentally friendly and more convenient than ever before.



LOHNER-PORSCHE SEMPER VIVUS. THE WORLD'S FIRST HYBRID.

Ask someone to name the world's first hybrid automobile and the responses are likely to range from models built in the late 1990s to the early 2000s. In fact, the first hybrid was conceived, designed and built in a small German factory almost 114 years ago. Its creator was none other than Ferdinand Porsche.

The argument against electric vehicles at the turn of the 19th century was the same as it is today: Limited range and a lack of charging infrastructure made such vehicles rather impractical. To get around this problem, the prodigious Porsche had a brilliant idea: What if the recharging station was portable, built into the car itself and powered by readily available gasoline?

In 1900, the inventor set to work on a car that used its gasoline engine not to power the drive wheels, but rather to spin a generator and create electricity. This electricity could then be used to power the hub-mounted motors, with any unneeded current going to recharge the onboard batteries. Such a vehicle would be an electric car (capable of being run on batteries alone, at least for limited distances), yet it would have a virtually limitless range as long as fuel was in the tank.

Working with the chassis of a previous electric car, Porsche took a pair of 2.5 horsepower De Dion-Bouton engines and mounted them behind the driver's bench seat. Each engine served two functions: spin a generator, providing power to the wheel hub motors and batteries, and drive a water pump to provide coolant to the engines. Propulsion came exclusively from the hub-mounted electric motors – there was no connection between the engines and the front drive wheels. Thus the first series hybrid automobile had been created. Porsche named it Semper Vivus, Latin for "always alive."

At its debut in Paris 1901, the Semper Vivus must have looked like something out of science fiction. And in many respects it was. While both it and its successor, the Lohner-Porsche Mixte, would remain relatively niche collector's items, they set the stage for cutting-edge Porsche hybrids of today, more than a century later.
