A Passion for Curves

“The curves lead down to the beach; in the north of Mallorca, the road to the Mediterranean takes a series of serpentine turns, like knotting a tie. You have to tap-dance on the pedals! Curves are really what make driving fun. Shifting down when you enter a curve, then letting up on the brake and turning in; giving gas at the midway point and accelerating smoothly out of it. The most important thing is to turn in at the right time, because that makes the curve’s radius larger.”
